Removed this section "Research Director will consult..." and include "Each year the Everybody for " Motion passed unanimously.
 - Vote on edits to "Performance Review and Development (PRD) Guide and Instruction Form". Language change regarding the deadline to submit PRD, including "no later than March 15." Review cover calendar year. When supervisor does not submit it, Tatiana will be notified. "Adds accountability for FS chair". Add "February" to deadline reminders. New hires should have set expectations, deliverables. Supervisors should be responsible for informing new hires of the PRD process and expectations within two months of hiring. Edit: one long PRD for employees with multiple time-splits. Supervisor who signs the timesheets should sign the document. Edit: If review is under 16, CAP is required. Vote: 36 in favor (8 online). Approved unanimously. Motion passed.
