**Call for Applicants for a Tenure Track Faculty Position in affiliation with
The Goldman Sonnenfeldt School for Sustainability and Climate Change,
Ben-Gurion University of the Negev**

The Goldman Sonnenfeldt School for Sustainability and Climate Change (GSSSCC), invites applications for a full-time tenure track position in the fields of **climatology and/or related fields**, starting 1.10.2024.

The candidate will become a faculty member in the department that best fits the candidate's field. Consequently, an ad-hoc committee will evaluate the candidate's suitability for the proposed position based on her/his expertise, the need of the relevant Department and the GSSSCC.

The position can be filled at any faculty rank, from Lecturer (the equivalent of assistant professor) to Full Professor. A Ph.D. in climatology and/or related areas is required. Candidates at the senior level must have a distinguished publication and service record. Candidates at the junior level must show great promise for extraordinary scholarship.

Demonstrating a profound commitment to research with direct implications for climate change, global warming, and sustainability is of utmost importance. Preference will be accorded to candidates whose research and teaching capabilities align closely with the overarching mission and objectives of the GSSSCC in the realm of climate and related studies.

The successful candidate will contribute to teaching in the relevant Department and in the GSSSCC's curriculum at all levels and engage with other University faculty working in related fields.

Applications should be submitted online no later than 31st January 2024 and include the following documents:

- Curriculum Vitae - including journal ISI grading and impact factor and Google scholar number of citations for each of the applicant's publications;
- Scientific biography;
- Research plans for the forthcoming years;
- Three letters of recommendation (directly submitted, on-line, by the referees. Please see directions on the online application site);
- List of courses that the candidate is capable of teaching;
- Copies of up to 3 recently published articles;

- A Teaching Statement and student assessment surveys, if available.

Appointment procedures will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of BGU and are subject to the approval of the university authorities. The GSSSCC and BGU are not obliged to appoint any of the candidates who apply for this position.
