## One-Year Term Position in Physical Geography at Northern Michigan University

The [Department of Earth, Environmental & Geographical Sciences](#) (EEGS) at Northern Michigan University ([NMU](#)), on the shore of Lake Superior in Marquette, invites applications for a one-year (nine-month) term position to begin in August 2024. The successful candidate will teach a full-time load of 12 credits in Fall 2024 and 12 credits in Winter 2025. The typical teaching load is three 4-credit courses per semester. This term position is a sabbatical replacement.

We seek a physical geographer, geomorphologist, soil scientist, or environmental scientist with demonstrated ability to teach in natural and physical science disciplines and experience applying quantitative analysis to address contemporary environmental challenges. The term instructor will teach three 4-credit courses per semester including Soils (lecture and labs), Geomorphology (lecture and lab), and Hydrology (lecture and lab). Additional desirable courses may include Physical Geography (introductory lecture) and Wetlands (lecture and lab). We welcome applicants with professional experiences suited to teaching interdisciplinary courses.

**Required minimum qualifications:** Master's degree in Geography, Earth Science, Geology, Soil Science, Environmental Science, or a closely related field with relevant university teaching experience. A Ph.D. is preferred.

The review of applications will begin on January 16, 2024 and continue until the position is filled. All applicants must include a letter detailing relevant teaching and professional experience; a curriculum vitae; and contact information (including names, addresses, email addresses, and telephone numbers) for three references.
