- Utilize geographic information systems (GIS) software to perform technical GIS activities
- Compile, input, and modify computer maps and data collection apps
- Collect in-field data using GPS and ESRI Field Maps application
- Maintain organized records of mapping processes and completed projects, ensuring easy access for team members
- Convert CAD files into shape files and confirm physical locations in the field using GPS
